Dear Parents, Carers and Guardians

Ahead of Easter and a wider end-of-term message, I take this opportunity to celebrate and shine a light on some of our many wonderful achievements.

On Monday, it was an absolute pleasure to be part of our Sixth Form Diploma Scholars' away day at the Royal Cornwall Museum. Our current Lower Sixth Diploma Scholars and our incoming 5th Year Scholars shared a morning of collaboration and curiosity with a real focus on Cornwall, its history and identity.

They were also treated to a visit behind the scenes to the archives and stores of this wonderful museum, viewing the combined partnership exhibition of Truro School's Art collection and key works from across Cornwall. That partnership, designed to widen educational access to inspiring Cornish art to children and adults alike, is one we and the museum have welcomed enthusiastically.

In the afternoon, the 5th Year incoming scholars, including those joining us in September from other schools, engaged with focus and insight into seminars on community identity and the very nature of science.

Our Sixth Form Diploma Scholars deliberately and proudly represent the breadth and diversity of ambition in our school. Selection is not just academic but is also about the broader interests that enable a pupil to embody our School's values and the aspiration of the Diploma framework. Excellence is never 'one size fits all'; a day like this was a great way to celebrate that.

Our approach to scholarship and enrichment at Truro School has evolved over the last few years to be more child-focused and progressive. Means-tested bursary awards remain available to apply for by any family, but we have detached the awarding of fee remission from most scholarships below the Sixth Form (except for our choristers and fencers). This enables the resources of the School to be invested in and targeted directly at the opportunities available to the children who gain scholarships. For example, we now award additional academic and co-curricular scholarships mid-year. This means that they are no longer reliant on high-stakes single moments of assessment at entry to the school.

In last week's Whole School Assembly, I was delighted to announce scholarship awards for a series of pupils in our 1st and 3rd Years based on how they have engaged academically or in our co-curriculum over the year thus far.

Many of the replies I had from children of their personal joy and sense of achievement at being recognised directly for their consistent commitment were truly uplifting. This has all been made possible by an approach that is child-centred in this way.

We will continue to develop and evolve our approach to enrichment and scholarship, including via the new Enrichment and Scholarship Co-ordinator post created within our staff body for this purpose. Every child in our school should have an equal entitlement to choose to be part of wider enrichment opportunities, and it is great to be able to reward those who choose to make the most of these opportunities regularly. On that uplifting note, I wish you all an enriching weekend and a positive last week of term ahead.

Diploma Scholars' Away Day

The Royal Cornwall Museum was a fabulous venue for a day of intellectual development and exploration for our Lower Sixth and our newly appointed 5th Year Diploma Scholars.

Expanding upon the 'colour profiling' initiative introduced during a recent off-site excursion, the Lower Sixth students shared their learnings and perspectives with the new scholars. This exchange aimed to promote self-reflection and focus on our school values of creativity and courage.

The day was overseen by the Head, Mr Johnson, Head of English, Ms Selvey, and the Head of Sixth Form, Mr Williamson. Current Lower Sixth scholar Alice described the day as enriching, highlighting the value of the scholarship route in fostering critical thinking, self-awareness, and practical application of knowledge for university and life beyond.

High-Flying Sixth Formers

Sixth Former, Theo W developed an early passion for aviation and was able to fly a plane before legally being able to drive a car.

Theo joins fellow sixth former Aimee W as two students recently offered prestigious aviation opportunities. Aimee has been offered a degree apprenticeship with Airbus, and Theo his L3 Harris ATPL, which will give him seven months of ground school followed by eight months of training in Florida.

Aimee, currently studying Maths, Physics, DT and Leiths, was keen to follow the degree apprenticeship route, which offers a degree and four years of industry work experience. Airbus' schemes are highly sought after and are renowned for their commercial plane aerospace engineering and involvement in the space industry, potentially presenting exciting opportunities for Aimee in space engineering.

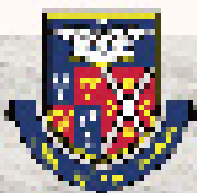
