*Dear Parents, Guardians, Carers,*

We are back! It has been just wonderful this week to see the School full of life, laughter, and learning. Your children have returned full of energy and ambition, mixed with the kinds of trepidation that we expect and are well placed to support at the start of a new academic year, and a new school for some. I am sure some body clocks have had abrupt adjustment, and there are many tales of summer endeavour being exchanged too. This is what should be happening and is why I am so pleased with what I see. But that is a thought that probably merits a year of exploration!

I am excited by this theme for a year in which we know we are continuing to build on good work to create culture here, to create shared purpose, and to create ever more consistency in what we do. I am also absolutely thrilled to be able to announce that yesterday, we were notified that Truro School has won a prestigious national award for our Creative and Performing Arts programme and ambitions (read more on page 4). In a strong field we knew we were a finalist, but the news breaking yesterday makes it a truly inspiring way to start our own year of creativity. I thank every pupil, parent, colleague, and advocate for creativity in our community for helping make this recognition possible.

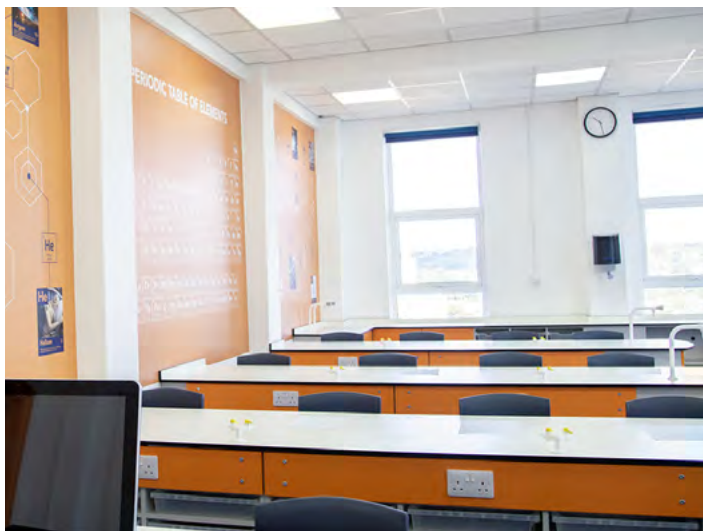

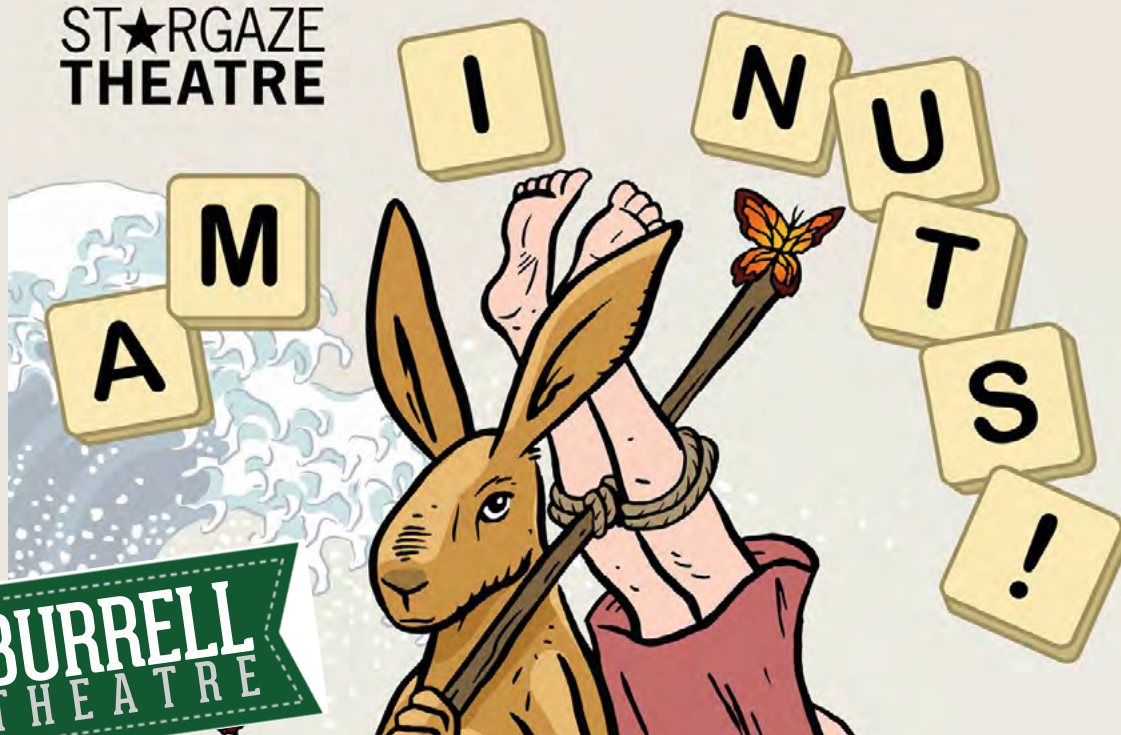

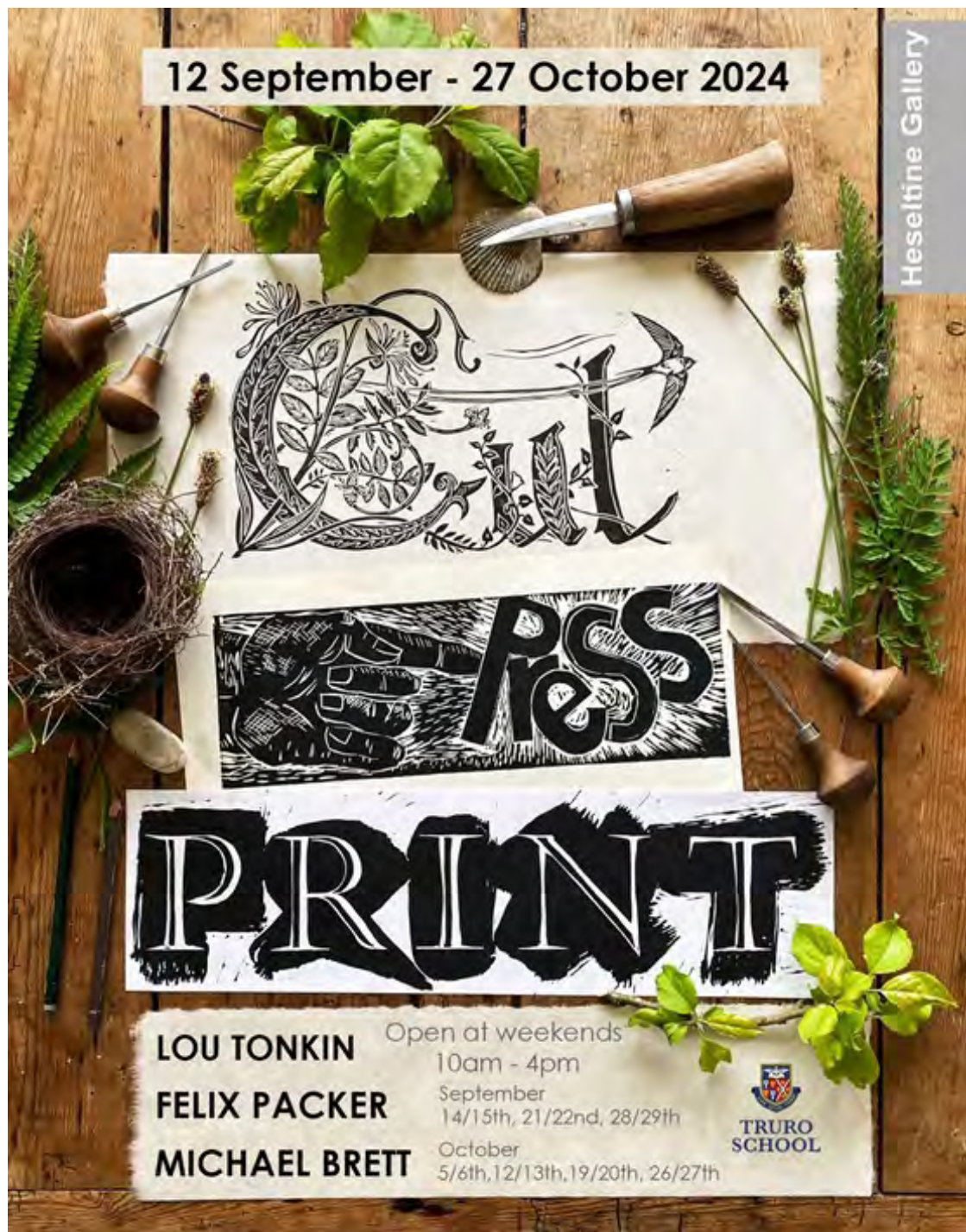

CutPressPrint is a collaboration between three contemporary printmakers in Cornwall who have created and curated an exciting and unique show that will open this Autumn in Truro School's Heseltine Art Gallery. Included in the show alongside the artist's work are works from the Truro School Art Collection by Peter Lanyon, Patrick Heron, Wilhelmina Barnes-Graham, Terry Frost and many other significant 20th Century Cornish artists.

Lou Tonkin, Felix Packer and Michael Brett are three professional contemporary printmakers living and working in Falmouth. Between them they have 100 years of creating art in Falmouth. In 2020 they started making work together on drawing trips and sharing their creative practices.
